## PUBLIC NOTICE

### Property Taxes due July 2, 2025

Property tax invoices are mailed out in May with a due date of July 2<sup>nd</sup>. Payments received after this date are subject to a 10% late payment penalty. Interest charges will accrue until the taxes are paid.

Payments may be made by cash, debit card or cheque (payable to Village of Haines Junction), online banking through CIBC, Bank of Montreal, TD Canada Trust or Scotiabank (vendor ID -Haines Junction (Village) Tax, account number - tax notice roll number) or by Interact email transfer to [finance@hainesjunction.ca](mailto:finance@hainesjunction.ca)

Residents that live at least 184 days of the calendar year on their property may be eligible for a Yukon Government **Homeowners Grant**. If you have lived at your property since January 1st of the current calendar year, the grant can be deducted at time of payment. The regular **Homeowners Grant** is 50% of current taxes to a maximum of \$450.00 and the seniors **Homeowners Grant** is 75% of current taxes to a maximum of \$500.00.

Please note that if you are paying online and are deducting the **Homeowners' Grant** at the time of payment, the grant amount will remain outstanding until the signed application form is submitted to the Village office and may be subject to the 10% late payment penalty if not received by the payment deadline.

**Please note that credit cards will not be accepted for payment of property taxes.**

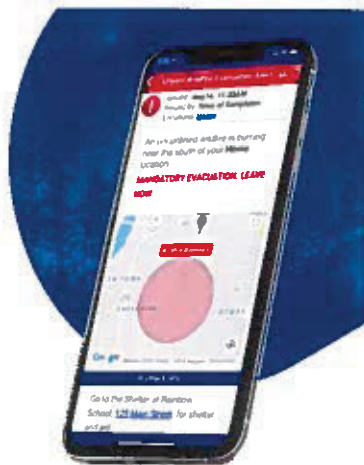

Voyent Alert! is a multi-purpose communication service provided by the Municipality of Haines Junction to keep you informed of critical events like fires or floods as well as day-to-day communications such as road maintenance and closures, water advisories, etc.

#### PERSONALIZED COMMUNICATIONS

Voyent Alert! provides informative communications. Critical information such as the distance and direction from an incident, and preferred evacuation routes from your followed locations may be provided.

#### FOLLOW MULTIPLE LOCATIONS

Voyent Alert! allows you to create and follow multiple locations such as "Kids School" or "Mom's House". Any event or communication related to your followed locations will be forwarded to you along your preferred communication channel.

#### COMMUNICATIONS YOUR WAY

Receive alerts over a wide variety of communication channels including mobile apps, text/SMS alerting, email or voice dial. You can register for one or more communication channels.

#### NO MESSAGE FAILURE

Smart alerting capabilities ensure that you will only get notified when a communication is relevant to your or one of the locations you are following.

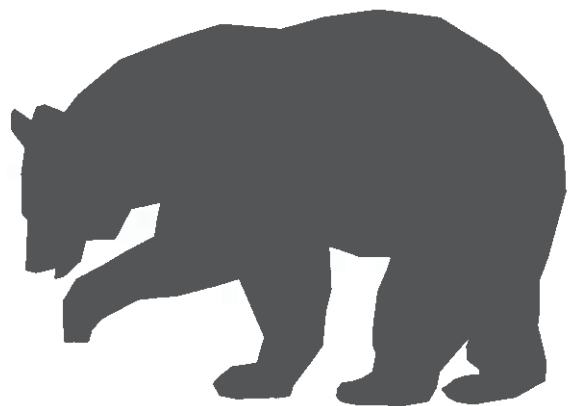

HHW Day provides Haines Junction & area residents with a valuable opportunity to dispose of hazardous waste properly and, most importantly, keep this waste out of our landfill. An Environmental Branch Inspector will be on-site to ensure all waste is collected and disposed of safely.

**Commercial hazardous waste is not accepted.**

HHW includes liquid paint, household cleansers, compact fluorescent light bulbs, motor oil, solvents, gasoline, barbeque starter, anti-freeze, household and car batteries, pesticides, aerosol cans and other
