Village Information

Council approved a public communications strategy in December 2023 that guides how staff communicate information to the public. This strategy recognizes that not all households have internet access or access to Facebook. Below are some of the ways that you can get access to information from your Municipal government:

Sign up to our email list – We distribute all Council Agenda packages, meeting minutes and public notices via email. Sign up by sending an email to corporate@hainesjunction.ca

Sign up for alerts - We distribute urgent information and information about events that may affect your day-to-day activities, such as water main breaks, changes in the landfill schedule and local emergencies, through an Alert system called Voyent Alert. You can choose how you would like to receive alerts (email, text or phone call). To sign up, visit voyent-alert.com

Visit our website - Information about Village programs and services, business listings, public notices and much more is available on our website. We've done a lot of work on the site in recent months, so if you haven't stopped by in a while, check it out! hainesjunction.ca

Noticeboards – The Village maintains a public notice board at the Post Office, and outside the Village Office at the St. Elias Convention Centre. We'll soon be adding a new noticeboard at the landfill. Notices are posted weekly.

Mailouts - Mailouts are both time consuming and expensive and are used when we need to ensure critical information reaches all members of our community.

Housing Accelerator Fund

The Village of Haines Junction, through the Housing Accelerator Fund, is offering two housing construction grant programs.

New Dwelling Construction Grant Program for Young Residents

Young residents (no older than 35 years of age on January 11, 2024) can apply for a grant to assist with construction of a new primary dwelling unit within the Village of Haines Junction. The maximum eligible grant per applicant to construct a new dwelling unit will be \$25,000 per dwelling.

Affordable Housing Grant

Local contractors and developers who responded to the Call for Expressions of Interest for Affordable Housing have been invited to apply for a grant to assist with construction of new affordable housing units within the Village of Haines Junction. The maximum eligible grant per dwelling unit will be 5% of eligible costs, up to \$25,000.

The deadline to apply for both grant programs is **November 5, 2024**.
