Call for Applicants: Trail Project Advisory Committee

The Village of Haines Junction is seeking **five** members for a Trail Project Advisory Committee. This is a temporary position.

The role of the Advisory Committee is to advise on a plan for placing signage on the trail network, including recommending sign content, locations of signs, proposing trail names, advising on the development of a trail network app. The Committee will follow guidance in the 2018 Trail Planning What We Heard Report and guidance from Champagne Aishihik First Nations. Administrative support will be provided by Village employees.

Successful appointees will serve one (1) year term, noting it is hoped that this project will be completed for summer 2024. We estimate five two-hour meetings will be required to complete this project. Members will be provided with an honorarium of \$100/meeting.

To be considered for this position you must have resided in Haines Junction for not less than three (3) years.

- Why you would like to be on this Project Advisory Committee
- Your experience with the Haines Junction Trail Network
- Relevant experience that would make you a good candidate for the Committee
