Casual Part-Time Skate Park Attendant

 The Village of Haines Junction is accepting employment applications for a casual part-time Skate Park Attendant. The position begins on June 16, 2025 and ends on August 24, 2025. Hours of work will be 12 hours per week over 3 days.

Duties and Responsibilities

Under the direction of the Public Works Manager, the Skate Park Attendant will ensure the safety and well-being of users, maintain the skatepark's facilities, and aid with equipment or instruction of the Skate Park located in the Bill Brewster Arena. Duties may include but are not limited to the following:

- Monitor user groups and ensure compliance with facility policy and regulations.
- Provide first aid and CPR in the event of an emergency
- · Assist youth with equipment
- Cleaning arena lobby, washrooms.
- Undertake public relations answering inquiries, respond to suggestions, handle complaints.
- Complete minor repairs and maintenance including charging of hover boards.
- · Keep a log of attendees
- Notify EMS and the Village Office in the event of any emergency.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications*

The successful candidate will have all or most of the following qualifications:

- Current Standard First Aid / CPR
- Ability to engage and effectively work with children
- The ability to effectively communicate verbally with the public.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and ability to work independently under minimal supervision.
- Experience with skateboards would be considered an asset.
- Able to meet the physical demands of the position including ability to lift 40 lbs.

THE VILLAGE OF HAINES JUNCTION OFFERS A RECYCLE PICK UP SERVICE TO HAINES JUNCTION RESIDENTS

We will pick up the following:

- ✓ Tin and foil
- ✓ Drink tetra packs
- ✓ Milk cartons (plastic & cardboard)
- ✓ Hard plastic
- ✓ Soft plastic (put in one bag)
- ✓ All paper products (not wet)
- ✓ Egg cartons
- ✓ Brown paper bags
- ✓ Cardboard & boxboard (flattened, not wet)
- ✓ Glass

Please:

- Clean your recyclables.
- Place your recyclables in a tub or box which we will empty and return to you.
- Take lids off containers and give them a rinse.
- Place paper in a separate bag so it won't get wet.
- Flatten items as much as possible as space is an issue (e.g., squish milk jugs, flatten cardboard, etc.)

If something is left in your bin that means we don't recycle it.

This service is provided free of charge once a week, please limit your bins to a max of two containers per household.

WE WILL NOT TAKE GARBAGE, AND STYROFOAM.
