

Property tax invoices are mailed out in May with a due date of July 2^{nd} . Payments received after this date are subject to a 10% late payment penalty. Interest charges will accrue until the taxes are paid.

Payments may be made by cash, debit card or cheque (payable to Village of Haines Junction), online banking through CIBC, Bank of Montreal, TD Canada Trust or ScotiaBank (vendor ID -Haines Junction (Village) Tax, account number - tax notice roll number) or by Interac email transfer to finance@hainesjunction.ca

Residents that live at least 184 days of the calendar year on their property may be eligible for a Yukon Government Home Owners Grant. If you have lived at your property since January 1st of the current calendar year, the grant can be deducted at time of payment. The regular Home Owners Grant is 50% of current taxes to a maximum of \$450.00 and the seniors Home Owners Grant is 75% of current taxes to a maximum of \$500.00.

Please note that if you are paying online and are deducting the Home Owners' Grant at the time of payment, the grant amount will remain outstanding until the signed application form is submitted to the Village office and may be subject to the 10% late payment penalty if not received by the payment deadline.

Please note that credit cards will not be accepted for payment of property taxes.

Do you operate a business within the Village of Haines Junction? If so, you are required to have a current business license issued by the Village of Haines Junction.

Licensed businesses within Haines Junction are listed on the Village of Haines Junction website. In the coming weeks, the Village will be taking steps to remove all businesses that do not have current licenses from the website. https://hainesjunction.ca/p/business-listings

The Village also issues Inter-Municipal Business Licenses that allows you to provide occasional sales/services in all Yukon communities. If you maintain an office space in more than one Yukon municipality, you must obtain a business license in each municipality in which you have

THE VILLAGE OF HAINES JUNCTION OFFERS A RECYCLE PICK UP SERVICE TO HAINES JUNCTION RESIDENTS

We will pick up the following:

- ✓ Tin and foil
- ✓ Drink tetra packs
- ✓ Milk cartons (plastic & cardboard)
- ✓ Hard plastic
- ✓ Soft plastic (put in one bag)
- ✓ Paper white, newspaper, coloured (not wet)
- ✓ Magazines
- ✓ Phone books & catalogues
- ✓ Egg cartons
- ✓ Brown paper bags
- ✓ Cardboard & boxboard (flattened, not wet)
- ✓ Glass



Please:

- Clean your recyclables.
- Place your recyclables in a tub or box which we will empty and return to you.
- Take lids off containers and give them a rinse.
- Place paper in a separate bag so it won't get wet.
- Flatten items as much as possible as space is an issue (e.g., squish milk jugs, flatten cardboard, etc.)

If something is left in your bin that means we don't recycle it.

This service is provided free of charge once a week, please limit your bins to a max of two containers per household.

WE WILL NOT TAKE GARBAGE, AND STYROFOAM.
