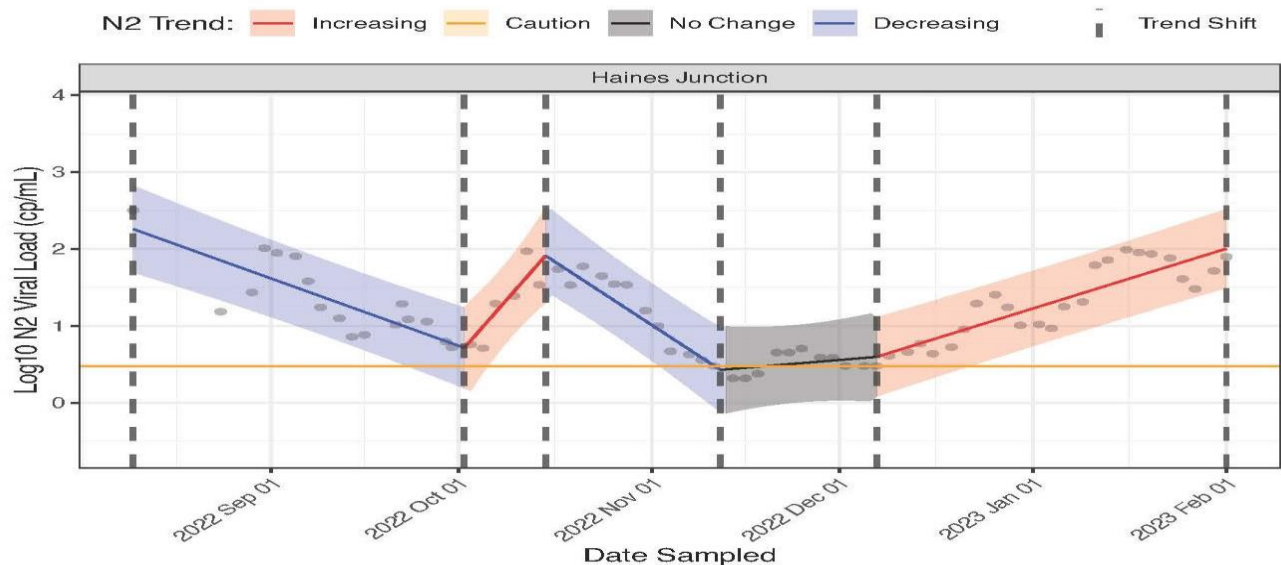

SARS-CoV-2 in Wastewater Long-Term Quantitative Trend Analysis



We are seeing a significant increase in COVID-19 in Dakwākāda/Haines Junction. This is shown in wastewater testing results and is also being reported by staff and Citizens.

It pays to take some easy extra precautions right now to avoid further spread and increased risk to our community and loved ones. COVID-19 is not just a cold. It poses more serious risks, especially to our Elders and most vulnerable.

SIMPLE. SAFE. SMART.

1. Please keep your vaccines current (this is the best way to prevent the severe form of COVID-19 and other viruses),
2. Protect yourself: wash your hands regularly and wear a mask when gathering with others, and Elders: We encourage Elders who test positive for COVID or are feeling sick to contact the health centre, your doctor or the emergency room for medical care. Elders and family members supporting Elders can ask about Paxlovid, which may be an option to help reduce the severity of COVID-19. Learn more at <https://yukon.ca/paxlovid>.

FEBRUARY IS HEART HEALTH MONTH

One of the best ways to keep your heart healthy is to know your blood pressure and checking it regularly. High blood pressure can lead to increased risk of stroke, heart failure, dementia, kidney disease, and eye problems. Before you can address high blood pressure, you have to know you're at risk. Know your numbers!

Blood pressure can be checked by a nurse at the health centre by appointment or drop in from Monday to Friday on the first floor. Call us to ask about availability!

COVID-19 VACCINE BOOSTERS

COVID-19 vaccine boosters are available at Haines Junction Health Centre for all ages that are eligible. Please call to inquire about appointment availability.

You may be eligible to receive a booster if six months have past since your last booster. If you've recently had COVID-19, it is recommended to wait until at least three months have passed since symptoms started or testing positive before getting your next vaccine or booster.

Call the clinic to find out about your eligibility and make an appointment. Flu shots will also be available at the booster clinic. Call 867-634-4444 to book an appointment.
